under Section 53 of the Communications Regulation Act 2002, as amended, to carry out

Proposed Major Roadworks on a National Road Other Than a Motorway/Dual Carriageway

Notes on completing this form:

- This form should be used by network operators when making an application to the National Roads Authority under section 53 of the Communications Regulations Act, 2002, as amended, for a consent to carry out proposed <u>major roadworks</u> on a national road other than a Motorway/ Dual Carriageway.
- 2. Applications relating to sections of national roads <u>other than</u> Motorways/Dual Carriageways should be made as follows:

Non-Motorway/Non-Dual Carriageway Rural National Roads

- Major Roadworks are defined to be works requiring the closure of a hard shoulder or part of the carriageway. Application for consent should be submitted to the Authority on Form T1.
- Minor Roadworks are all works not requiring the closure of a hard shoulder or part of the carriageway. Application for consent should be submitted to the Authority on Form T3.

Urban National Roads

- Major Roadworks are defined to be works requiring excavations greater than 5 sq.m in area. Application for consent should be submitted to the Authority on Form T1.
- Minor Roadworks are works requiring excavations less than 5 sq.m in area. Application for consent should be submitted to the Authority on Form T3.
- 3. Applications in relation to Motorway/ Dual Carriageway sections of the national road network should be made on Form MD1.
- 4. Applications relating to sections of roads <u>other than national</u> <u>roads</u> should be made to the <u>road authority</u> concerned (the NRA has no statutory function in relation to consent applications concerning non national roads).
- 5. Before completing this form, please refer to the Authority's policies set out in our "Guide to the use of Underground Road Capacity on National Roads for Electronic Communications Infrastructure", which was prepared under section 53 (11) of the Act and the Authority's Charges Schedule. The documents

concerned are available to view/download on the Authority's website, www.nra.ie/roadworks

- 6. Payment of an administrative fee must accompany the roadworks consent application, payable by cheque/postal order to the National Roads Authority. Please refer to the Schedule of Charges in our "Guide to the use of Underground Road Capacity on National Roads for Electronic Communications Infrastructure" for details of application fees.
- 7. Applicants should note that, as part of the consultation process provided for under section 53(3)(a) of the Communications Regulations Act, 2002, as amended, consent applications must be forwarded by the Authority to the road authority/authorities within whose administrative area the section of national road concerned is located. The legislation provides for a consultation period of up to 21 days. The Authority will advise you of our proposed decision as soon as possible following completion of the consultation process.
