






Key Elements

- Guidance and Standards apply to all TII Major and Minor Projects and Greenways
- Engagement of "Competent Experts"
- CHIA to be structured around and proportionate to the phases and stages set out in TII's Project Management Guidelines or PMG.
- Four-step process of assessment
- Key deliverables:
 - Assessment Method Statements
 - Cultural Heritage Datasets (CHDs)
 - Geospatial data (GIS/CAD) and mapping
 - Reports
 - Project Archives
 - Input on Multi-Criteria Analysis (MCA) and Project Appraisal Balance Sheets (PABS).











What does this mean for us?

- Be aware that the new Cultural Heritage Impact Assessment Guidance and Standards for TII Projects are in the pipeline.
- Familiarise yourself with the new requirements if necessary.
- Once the new Guidance and Standards are approved and published, incorporate their requirements into future project specifications.
