RM 22- Dubber Cross Bridge (FG-M50-005.00)

The works are as follows:

- Concrete repairs required over southbound lane (0.8m²)
- Concrete repairs required over northbound lane (0.2m²)

This bridge carries the R112 over the M50 in Finglas. The bridge is not connected to any Natura 2000 Site. The nearest Natura 2000 site is the Rye Water Carton SAC which is 7.4 km from the bridge. Repairs are required following bridge strikes.

RM 23- Cloverhill Road Bridge (SD-M50-004.00)

The works are as follows:

• Concrete repairs required over northbound lane (0.3m²)

This concrete slab bridge carries the Cloverhill Road over the M50 in Neillstown. The bridge is not connected to any Natura 2000 Site. The nearest Natura 2000 site is the Rye Water Carton SAC which is 9 km from the bridge. Repairs are required following a bridge strike.

RM 26 - Knocklyon footbridge (SD-M50-023.00)

The works are as follows:

Resurfacing and waterproofing 6m² on bridge deck.

This concrete box beam bridge carries the Knocklyon Footbridge over the M50. This bridge is not connected to any Natura 2000 Site. The nearest Natura 2000 site is the Glenasmole Valley SAC which is 3.7 km from the bridge. A fire was lit on the bridge deck, damaging the surfacing and waterproofing.
